SHARE JESUS WITHOUT FEAR

THE FIVE SHARE JESUS QUESTIONS

1. What are your spiritual beliefs/worldview?
2. To you, who is Jesus Christ?
3. Do you think there is a heaven or hell?
4. If you died, where would you go? If heaven, why?
5. The Bible has a lot to say about this. Do you mind if I share it with you?

Response to the first four questions: “hmmm.”

THE SEVEN SCRIPTURES

If they are open to you sharing the Scriptures with them, ask them, “Read this Scripture aloud”. Then ask them, “What does this say to you?” When they answer, just go to the next verse. You are in the page-turning business with one goal, to stay out of God’s way.

1. Romans 3:23: *“for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God”.*
2. Romans 6:23: *“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”* (Point out that it says “sin”. There is no “s”. God said only one sin is needed to send me to hell. And point out the word “death”, which often refers to hell in the Bible)
3. John 3:3: *“Jesus replied, ‘Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again.’”* (Ask, “Why did Jesus come to die?”)
4. John 14:6: *“Jesus answered, ‘I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.’”*
5. Romans 10:9-11: *“If you declare with your mouth, ‘Jesus is Lord,’ and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. As Scripture says, ‘Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame.’”*
6. 2 Corinthians 5:15: *“And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.”*
7. Revelation 3:20: *“Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me.”*

THE FIVE DECISION QUESTIONS

1. Are you a sinner? – Romans 3:23
2. Do you want forgiveness of sins? – Romans 6:23
3. Do you believe Jesus died on the cross for you and rose again? – Romans 10:9-11
4. Are you willing to surrender your life to Jesus Christ?

5. Are you ready to invite Jesus into your life and into your heart as both Savior and Lord?

Now: while you are waiting for the person to respond to these questions, please be silent and pray in your mind, not out loud. Be silent and await an answer. There are only two answers: yes or no. If “yes” comes from a person’s heart, this is the precise moment they become born again. You may ask them to pray or lead them in prayer (like the prayer written below). If the answer is “no”, ask, “Why?”

A PRAYER

“Heavenly Father, I have sinned against you. I want forgiveness of all my sins. I believe that Jesus is your Son and that He died on the cross for me and rose again. Father, I give you my life to do with as you wish. I want Jesus Christ to come into my life and into my heart as Lord and Savior. This I ask in Jesus’ name. Amen.”
